Because of your generosity to *Heritage of Sharing*, MMBB is blessed to have the resources to make emergency assistance and other benefits available to our members and their families. The gifts you gave in 2010—as we simultaneously turn the corner on our 100th anniversary—afford me the opportunity to reflect on the history of *Heritage of Sharing*.

In its earliest years, MMBB supported ministers and missionaries through grants. In fact, since 1913, MMBB has made grants totaling nearly \$240 million to both clergy and lay members, primarily from its endowment. However, by 2004, it became clear that—despite its size—our endowment simply could not meet the need. Thus, *Heritage of Sharing* was born.

This campaign asks those who have been financially blessed to contribute in order to assist others who have dedicated their lives to Christ's work. In 2010, your donations made possible grants, subsidies and emergency assistance totaling more than \$4 million. ## ENCARNACION LORENTE: 100 YEARS OF CELEBRATION

MABB was honored to provide assistance to Encarnacion for dental work recently through *Heritage of Sharing*—even more so when we learned about the rich life she and her husband Pascual shared in Cuba and, beginning in 1970, in the U.S. Their story is one of changing social and political climates with one common thread: service, faith and love.

Rev. Pascual Alcibiades Lorente was born in 1908, the youngest child of a large family in the countryside of Cuba. He carried his mother's last name, Lorente, as he was not recognized by his father—a pain that he carried throughout his life. His daughter Hulda remembers her father telling her when she was a child that God was his only father, and by all accounts, his devotion to the Lord maintained him throughout his life.

While in the seminary, Pascual tended a mission on weekends in the nearby town of Alto Songo, where he met Encarnacion and began to court her by mail. After graduating from seminary, he was sent to a mission at the farthest location on the Eastern end of Cuba in a small town called Baracoa, populated almost entirely by only one family. During his time in Baracoa, Pascual brought to fruition the foundation of a public school, the opening of a post office, and introduced vaccination for various diseases common to the area under the auspices of the health department.

When Rev. Lorente was transferred to the town of Cueto, the time was right, and he proposed to Encarnacion. She accepted, and they started a school in the living room of the parish house teaching children of church members how to count and read. There was no electricity and no refrigerators, and ice was purchased from a horse-pulled carriage. Drinking water was delivered in large tanks in similar fashion, deposited in *tinajas* (large clay containers) or poured into two pieces of porcelain made into containers divided by a filtering porous stone, with a faucet in the lower one.

Both Pascual and Encarnacion were able to achieve master's degrees in education as their family grew to include a son, Abdiel, and a daughter, Hulda. They named the school they founded "Colegio Bautista Salem," which grew from a few children taught in the living room to more than 200 students in various classrooms. They were even able to build a Baptist Church temple in Cueto that stands to this day as a landmark, with a new generation of young Baptist ministers continuing God's work in that small town.

A terrible tragedy in 1970 brought Pascual, Encarnacion and Hulda to the U.S., where Abdiel had gone to study in 1958. Abdiel first attended Eastern University, an American Baptist college in St. David's, PA, and then went on

to medical school at Temple University in Philadelphia. He married a nurse and began his residency after medical school in Syracuse in 1970. On July 4 that year, he and his wife were in a car accident with their six-week old baby girl, who was killed on impact; both Abdiel and his wife would remain hospitalized for months in critical condition. Encarnacion received the terrible news via friends in Spain—as no direct communications existed between the U.S. and Cuba—and she, Pascual and Hulda were able to make their way via Madrid to Syracuse by mid-July.

The Lorente family was met at the airport by two Baptist ministers who knew Abdiel from First Baptist Church of Manlius, NY, and eventually found sanctuary with another Cuban family who knew Pascual from his last pastorate until they were able to learn English and find work. Pascual subsequently began a ministry for Puerto Ricans and Cubans from different denominations, and Encarnacion found work as a nurse's aide. They spent the rest of their marriage in the U.S., eventually moving to St. Petersburg where Encarnacion leads a Bible study group with three other women from Liberty Baptist Church. She wrote to us to confirm: "I had the privilege to be the wife and helper in service to the Lord for many with my husband, Pascual. Before Pascual was called home by the Lord in 2006, he had several major surgeries, and we were grateful for MMBB's assistance during this time—and now, as it continues."

Encarnacion enjoys attending the MMBB annuitant luncheons each year, as seeing other ministers and their spouses helps her stay connected. We look forward to another beautiful smile in her 100th birthday picture this coming February!

## **GAIL (WRIGHT) LANGE AND ARTHUR LANGE, JR.** THE GRANDDAUGHTER OF MMBB'S FIRST RECORDING SECRETARY CONTINUES HIS GOOD WORKS

Gail and Arthur Lange have been contributors to MMBB for more than 20 years. As the granddaughter of the Reverend Dr. Peter Clark Wright, the work we do resonates strongly with Gail.

Dr. Wright was the first recording secretary of MMBB, beginning in 1911, and was instrumental in setting up the Board. He served as executive director from 1926 to 1940, moving MMBB into the modern investment era by establishing what eventually became the Retiring Pension Fund.

As Gail notes, "My reasons for giving to MMBB include expressing my deep affection for my grandfather, and I also felt it was a caring way to remember my brother, Foster D. Wright, by helping others." Gail and Arthur started the Foster D. Wright memorial as a token of their gratitude.

"My grandfather passed away in 1947 and my brother passed away in 1985, but their good works live on," writes Gail. "We are honored to give to MMBB."

## **REV. GEORGE BENNETT**

Rev. George Bennett is one of MMBB's many long-time members: he joined in 1945 and retired 30 years later in 1975. He is also proud to be an ongoing contributor to *Heritage of Sharing*.

George was born in England and attended Moody Bible Institute in Chicago, where he met his wife, Elizabeth, a pianist. They celebrated many years of marriage before she passed away in 2001. He originally served a church in Illinois before continuing his service with the American Baptist Home Mission Society and the Leprosy Mission.

"I donate to MMBB to help other retired ministers and missionaries—it's a blessing to be able to give," George explained. Beyond his annual donation, George has also graciously included MMBB in his will.

George has pursued many hobbies throughout his lifetime, including wood carving and creating greeting cards for others on the computer during his retirement years. He moved into an assisted living facility near his son, James, in 2010, the same year he celebrated his 100th birthday. As he approaches his 101st birthday this summer, MMBB is honored to consider him as a member of our family.

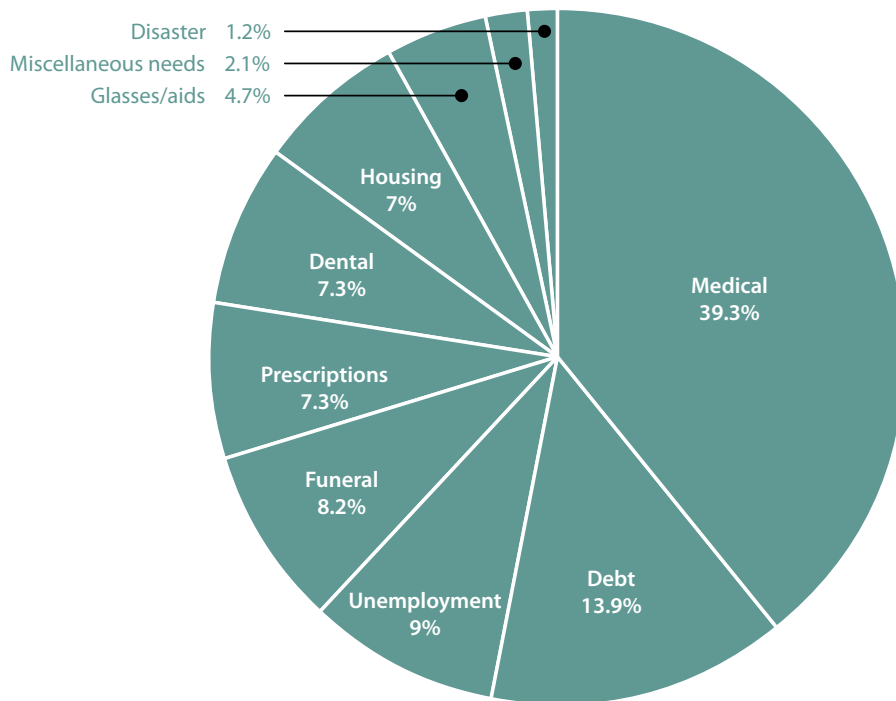
